



AN SOS CHILDREN'S VILLAGE VISIT

BASSE BOARD GAME - HOW TO PLAY

What you need to play:

- A group of 2-4 players.
- A marker for each player, for example a coin, paper clip or a rubber.
- A die for each group of players.
- The board game cards, cut out and placed face down next to the board.

Aim of the game: The winner of the game is the player who first reaches the 'Finish' square. During the game, the players will get to visit places and people in the SOS Children's Village in Basse, the Gambia.

1. Play in groups of 3 - 4.
2. Throwing the die, the first player moves his/her marker forwards accordingly. If the marker ends up on a 'pick a card' square, the player must take the top card from pile in the middle of the board, read out the short text on it to the other players. The player must then follow the instruction at the end of the card.
3. After the player have read out the text on the card, the card is placed at the bottom of the pile.
4. The game is finished when all players have reached the 'Finish' square.
